Over 2017/2018, this program funded 23 projects totalling \$211,129.

McMurdo Bench-Golden	Build a fence around an area that protects cattle from grazing near a domestic water intake.	\$6,921
McMurdo Bench-Golden	Upgrade existing water diversion to return diverted water to a stream after use and install two new water tanks. Remove conifer regeneration from pasture to improve forage production for livestock and wildlife.	\$4,405
Francis Creek-Radium	Build a 'hanging fence' to keep livestock out of riparian areas of Francis Creek.	\$1,806
Pickering Hills-Wardner	Invasive plant control using non-chemical methods.	\$7,580
Pickering Hills-Wardner	Invasive plant control using non-chemical methods.	\$6,570
Peckhams Lake range unit-Ft. Steele	Create pasture to improve forage production for livestock and wildlife.	\$5,780

Spillimacheen-Radium	Repair fence and replace a wire gate with a recycled cattle guard. Replace aging corral.	\$5,879
Sheep Creek-Skookunchuck	Replace fence to protect Gina Lake wetlands. Replace aging range fence.	\$14,210
Various locations in the East Kootenay	Invasive plant control.	\$73,000
Gold-Plumbob-Newgate	Replace narrow cattle guards with wider ones to accommodate recreational vehicles.	\$2,049
Gold-Plumbob-Newgate	Install new range fence to mitigate conflicts between livestock and recreational users at Englishman Creek Recreation Site.	\$9,855
Cherry-Tata Creek	Assess forage response to ecosystem restoration treatments 20 years after treatment.	\$5,250
yaqan nuʔkiy	Install new range fence to permit rotational grazing.	\$5,000
yaqan nuʔkiy	Upgrade existing fence to protect riparian areas adjacent to Goat River.	\$5,000
yaqan nuʔkiy	Install two new cattle guards to facilitate compatible uses of rangeland.	\$5,000
Francis Creek-Radium	Upgrade existing fence on Steamboat Mountain inaccessible area.	\$678
Wildhorse-Lewis, near Wasa	Install painted cattle guard on Lazy Lake Road to prevent people-livestock conflicts.	\$2,100
Wildhorse-Lewis, near Wasa	Build new corral.	\$8,679

Wildhorse-Lewis, near Wasa	Build new range fence adjacent to wetland habitat.	\$8,975
Grasmere	Upgrade posts on existing fences.	\$4000
Grasmere	Rehabilitate damaged areas, created by vehicles and ATV use in the area. Install interpretive signage about fostering sustainable and responsible recreating in the Koocanusa area.	\$15,000
Joseph Creek- Cranbrook	Enhance existing water features to provide alternative watering site for livestock.	\$1,120
