Elkford	District of Elkford	Boivin Creek Corridor	Enhance the city centre area of the corridor with new picnic tables, benches, lighting and signage.	\$351,750
Invermere	District of Invermere	Downtown Invermere Revitalization	Help ensure that downtown Invermere remains a vibrant centre for residents and visitors.	\$150,000
Johnsons Landing	Johnsons Landing Community Association	Johnsons Landing Community Hall Picnic Area	Enhance the hall's grounds by adding a picnic area and fencing to delineate the recreation and picnic areas from the parking lot.	\$11,444
Kaslo	Kaslo Outdoor Recreation and Trails Society	Kaslo Family Bike Park Picnic Shelter	Build a picnic shelter in the park to enhance time spent outdoors for all community members.	\$17,535
Lardeau	Lardeau Valley Historical Society	Museum Grounds Landscaping	Increase the landscaped area around the museum to add more community event space and allow for additional outdoor exhibits.	\$5,265
Nelson	City of Nelson	Cottonwood Falls Park Enhancements	Enhance the useability, aesthetics and safety of the park by installing shade structures, seasonal lighting, planters and bike racks and improving accessibility to the falls.	\$219,152
New Denver	Village of New Denver	New Denver Centennial Park Stage and Gathering Space	Enhance the park by adding a lakefront gathering space, public stage and year-round public washroom.	\$458,333
Rossland	City of Rossland	RossGlen Park Revitalization Project	Add a gazebo and landscaping to the park to create a covered outdoor location to hold family reunions, small weddings or other recreation programming.	\$130,280

Rossland	City of Rossland	Rossland Museum & Discovery Centre Upper-level Revitalization	Redevelop the centre's outdoor public spaces to provide gathering spaces for the museum and community by building a pavilion, an outdoor sitting area and a walking loop with interpretive historical and ecological information.	\$99,050
