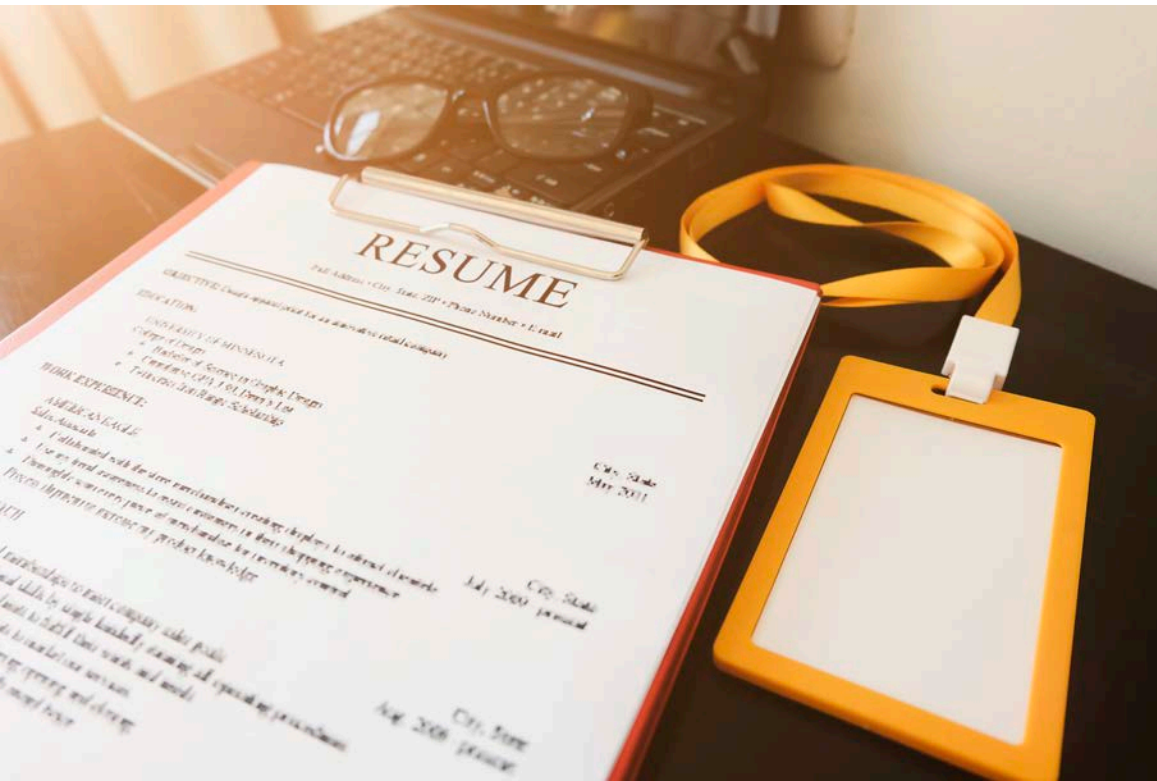

- ★ Ensure your email address is appropriate.
- ★ Highlight your skills, strengths and accomplishments that are relevant to this position.
- ★ Learn how to make strong skill statements.
