	For all proposed projects, we recommend submitting, at minimum:	☐ Complete application ☐ Letters of support ☐ Outcomes of community engagement if any ☐ Other documents as relevant and available, such as quotes for sub-contracted activities, copies of permit authorization applications and/or approvals, and/or report executive summaries.
+	Add if project proposes to develop/update a prescription or burn plan.	☐ Email confirmation of project approval in principle from Ministry of Forests (FOR) (see Section 7 of the Program Guide). ☐ PDF map of proposed project location, including polygon showing approximate area of the proposed project, and preferably georeferenced.
+	Add if project proposes to manage wildfire fuel.	☐ Email confirmation of project approval in principle from FOR (see Section 7 of the Program Guide). ☐ Copy of the fuel management prescription, signed and sealed by a Registered Professional Forester, including all ancillary assessments (e.g. terrain stability). Submit even if prescription requires updating as part of this project. ☐ Copy of prescribed fire burn plan. Activities that fall under the practice of forestry must be developed and, where applicable, signed and sealed by a forest professional that is accredited by Forest Professionals BC and operating within their scope of practice. ☐ PDF map of treatment unit(s), preferably georeferenced (Note that if proposing fuel management, spatial data is required to be entered into RESULTS. Speak with a wildfire advisor for
