Balfour	Balfour Senior Citizens Association Branch #120	Install blown-in insulation in the attic of the Seniors Hall.	\$2,860
Baynes Lake	Baynes Lake Community Society	Install two heat recovery ventilation (HRV) units, add attic insulation, fire-resistant metal roofing and ventilation at Baynes Lake Community Hall.	\$21,610
Castlegar	Freedom Quest Youth Services Society	Install an air source heat pump, insulation, fire- resistant siding and energy efficient windows at office building and youth treatment centre.	\$97,880
Castlegar	Kootenay Doukhobor Historical Society	Install an air source heat pump and LED lighting in the Bistro building and new HVAC and LED lighting in the South Annex building at the Doukhobor Discovery Centre.	\$37,650
Edgewood	Royal Canadian Legion No. 203	Install LED lighting, improve thermal performance of windows and add insulation to the main floor thrift store area.	\$49,500

Kimberley	Kimberley Health- Care Auxiliary	Install a new heating and HRV unit, a condensing boiler, thermal insulation on domestic hot water lines, LED lighting and energy efficient windows and doors at Thrift Shop.	\$101,920
Kimberley	Lee SPARK Society for Youth	Upgrade ceiling and wall insulation, install a new furnace and ducting, domestic hot water tank, HRV, LED lighting, windows and doors at the Spark Society Youth Centre.	\$145,500

Oasis	Oasis Recreational Society	Install LED lighting, a heat pump and high-efficiency furnace combo unit and insulated front doors at Oasis Hall.	\$12,800
Parson	Parson Community Hall Society	Install fire-resistant exterior siding, increase exterior insulation and interior ceiling and basement floor insulation and install drainage rock, weeping tile and a new retaining wall at Parson Community Hall.	\$168,044

Revelstoke	Revelstoke Heritage Railway Society	Install perforated window coverings and large-scale fan at the Revelstoke Heritage Railway Museum.	\$17,100
Salmo	Salmo Valley Youth & Community Centre Society	Install LED lighting at the Salmo Valley Youth and Community Centre.	\$14,360
Slocan	W.E. Graham Community Services Society	Complete electrical upgrades to support full utilization of existing (previously Trust-funded) solar panels.	\$28,010
Trail	Trail & District Daycare Society	Install exterior shade awnings, an air source heat pump and energy efficient hot water heater at Sunshine Children's Centre.	\$27,900
