Creston	Creston Valley Gleaners Society	Purchase a baler, cooler and power jack.	\$61,700
Fruitvale	Communities in Faith Pastoral Charge	Purchase two shelving and a refrigerator.	\$3,000
Invermere	Columbia Valley Food Bank	Install a freight lift from the basement storage to the main floor, improving efficiency and safety.	\$116,000
Nelson	Governing Council of the Salvation Army in Canada	Purchase a fridge, shelving, cart and digital scale.	\$11,100
Nelson	Nelson Community Food Centre	Purchase two freezers, shelving units and an industrial oven.	\$55,700
Nelson	St. Saviour's Pro-Cathedral	Purchase shelving, storage bins and appliances.	\$31,100
New Denver	New Denver and Area Community Hamper Society	Make infrastructure improvements to the food bank layout.	\$12,000
Revelstoke	Community Connections Revelstoke Society	Purchase a washer, dryer, two fridges and food bins to sort, organize and display food items.	\$18,100
Salmo	Salmo Community Resource Society	Purchase appliances and shelving.	\$20,000
Slocan	W.E. Graham Community Services Society	Purchase shelving and appliances.	\$21,100
Trail	Communities in Faith Pastoral Charge	Purchase a food cooler.	\$3,200
Trail	Governing Council of the Salvation Army in Canada	Purchase a fridge, shelving, bins, cart and worktable.	\$27,800
