

BUILT HERITAGE GRANTS 2018 INTAKE: LIST OF PROJECTS APPROVED FOR FUNDING

Launched in 2017, the Built Heritage Grants are a three-year, \$6.15-million commitment to help groups preserve, rehabilitate and restore heritage buildings. The grants are administered by Heritage BC. In this intake, the Trust is supporting 14 projects with \$1.2 million.
