

HERITAGE, MUSEUM AND ARCHIVE GRANTS 2019: LIST OF PROJECTS APPROVED FOR FUNDING

The Heritage, Museum and Archive Grants are providing \$1.05 million over three years for projects that help meet the sector’s needs. The grants are administered by Heritage BC. In this intake, the Trust is supporting 26 projects with \$407,455.
