ᑭᓄᓂᓄ	ᑭᓄᓂᓄ	Playground Community Space	Create a seating area with a shade structure, tables and trees on the school playground, which can be an outdoor classroom and a family gathering space within the community.	\$25,000
Castlegar	City of Castlegar	Millennium Park Upgrades	Expand the existing washroom facility by adding change rooms and showers to enable more family use of the swimming ponds and the multiple amenities within the park.	\$322,031
Cranbrook	City of Cranbrook	City Hall Parkette	Develop a new gazebo, chess tables, benches and a location for future art installations at the small park beside City Hall in partnership with the local chess club and JCI Kootenay.	\$75,000
Creston	Regional District of Central Kootenay	Lister Park Upgrades	Make external additions to Lister Park Hall to add accessible public washrooms with showers, a covered outdoor kitchen space that can open into the community hall kitchen and a pavilion, all in one contained location; also add a new open-air structure for year-round cultural activities.	\$402,641
Edgewater	Regional District of East Kootenay	Edgewater Rink Pavilion	Construct a roof over the recently renovated Frank's Outdoor Rink to develop a large outdoor pavilion for summer and winter use; this new feature—in addition to onsite amenities such as a firepit, washrooms and a commissary—will be a focal point of village activities.	\$129,439
Elkford	District of Elkford	Elkford's Meeting Place	Develop a bare space between the new District office and the Community Conference Centre with a gazebo, fire pit and landscaping so it can serve as a focal point for outdoor community gatherings.	\$340,781

Fernie	City of Fernie	Eirin Amundsen Memorial Pavilion	Build a pavilion at Max Turyk Recreation Area that will be available for visitor use, for community events and as outdoor classroom space; include an enclosed area for equipment storage and future program use.	\$40,500
Kaslo	Village of Kaslo	Front Street Park Additions	Add to the existing park with a live performance structure, accessible washrooms and storage for market activities; also add landscaping and lighting.	\$435,631
Kimberley	City of Kimberley	Kimberley Platzl Phase Two	Build on the previous year's work by creating three defined entrance arches, adding portable festival and family seating and tables, resurfacing the breezeway path and enhancing the gazebo stage sound system for public performances; also help businesses update their facades.	\$140,716
Nelson	City of Nelson	Hall Street Pier	Enhance the aesthetics, usability and safety of the area surrounding the pier, allowing a variety of community uses, as well as visually and functionally connecting upper Hall Street to lower Hall Street (waterfront and pier).	\$500,000
Slocan	Village of Slocan	Tenacity Skatepark Grounds Revitalization	Revitalize the grounds adjacent to the Tenacity Skate Park by adding signage, landscaping, shade covering, seating, and by repairing the community cobb oven to make it a community space.	\$52,350
