Public Art Grants help communities buy and install permanent art by Basin artists in public spaces.

| Golden | Métis Nation Columbia River Society | Create a mural on the curling rink to depict Métis culture. | \$28,600 |
| Kaslo | Kaslo Outdoor Recreation and Trail Society | Create a sculpture for the series "Discover the Koots," which will comprise large, woodland-inspired sculptures. | \$15,836 |
| Nakusp | Arrow Lakes District Arts Council Society | Create a large mural downtown of a western toad. | \$9,646 |
| Slocan | Village of Slocan | Create a sculpture for the series "Discover the Koots," which will comprise large, woodland-inspired sculptures. | \$16,636 |
| Sparwood | District of Sparwood | Create a street banner program using the art of local artists and constructed from a high-quality aluminum material similar to that of street signs. | \$20,000 |
| Trail | Trail and District Arts Council | Create a mural along the parking area adjacent to the Bailey Theatre. | \$11,100 |
