Balfour	Balfour Recreation Commission	Enhancing Balfour Community Outdoor Space	Build a multi-use gazebo with barbeque area, new washrooms, equipment storage facilities and overall improvements to the green space.	\$290,180
Canal Flats	Village of Canal Flats	Canal Flats Downtown Streetscape Beautification - Phase 1	Restore and enhance the eastern side of one block of Grainger Road in downtown Canal Flats as a central community gathering place.	\$55,519
Fauquier	Fauquier Community Club	Fauquier Community Gathering Space	Construct a timber frame pavilion on grounds next to the Fauquier's Community Club and tennis courts to create an outdoor gathering space and facilities.	\$243,742
Marysville	City of Kimberley	Improving Marysville Downtown District	Update lighting, street furniture and add washroom facilities to encourage visitors to downtown shops and restaurants in Marysville.	\$175,570
Nelson	City of Nelson	Rosemont Multigenerational Park Project	Increase use and accessibility for all generations at Art Gibbons Park with the addition of paved accessible walkways, picnic tables, benches and shade shelter.	\$75,000
Revelstoke	City of Revelstoke	Revitalization of Grizzly Plaza	Replace the Grizzly Plaza bandstand and update lighting, street furniture, wayfinding signage and landscaping for increased use of public events and programming.	\$322,050

Taghum	Taghum Community Society	Taghum Hall Grounds Improvements	Transform the area surrounding Taghum Hall into a welcoming venue for families and visitors to enjoy all year round.	\$114,729
Ymir	Ymir Community Association	Ymir Riverside Community Park Upgrades	Build a new gazebo and upgrade washroom facilities to support community gatherings at Riverside Community Park.	\$24,300
