Luxor Creek, North of Radium	Restore grasslands damaged by motorized recreational use. Erect educational signage and re-direct ATV trail to mitigate damage to fences.	\$1,975

Waldo, East Kootenay	Monitor effectiveness of ecosystem restoration treatments.	\$9,128
Waldo, South of Jaffray	Build riparian exclusion fence to protect wetland habitat from impact of livestock use.	\$2,626
Waldo, South of Jaffray	Apply grass-seed to prevent establishment of invasive plants following logging on rangeland.	\$2,970
Waldo, South of Jaffray	Replace dilapidated range fence and install cattle guards and gates to accommodate public recreation.	\$11,839
